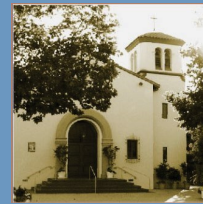

CLERGY CORNER

Alleluia alleluia alleluia! Happy Easter to all! I especially want to congratulate and welcome the newest members of our church, the newly baptized. After forty days of fasting, it is time to feast. Easter is the Church's greatest feast, in which we celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus Christ, who conquered death once and for all! This is the act of redemption that saved us from the powers of sin and death and is the reason why Easter is so important. The paschal mystery (the passion, death, resurrection, and ascension) of Jesus, which is commemorated at every liturgy, and which receives greater attention during Easter, is foundational to our faith. Sin separated us from God, yet he reconciled the world to himself. The paschal mystery is linked to the Passover in Exodus, when the Hebrew slaves were led by Moses out of Egypt. One of the prescriptions of the Passover meal was the sacrifice of a lamb. Through his own sacrifice, Jesus became the lamb that takes away our sins and frees us from slavery to sin. This is why Jesus is called the Lamb of God. The season of Easter is a triumphant time, and a time to be joyful. As we celebrate this season at church and in our homes, may we be grateful for the wonderful gift of salvation that Jesus won for us, and reflect the joyful spirit of the resurrection. Alleluia, alleluia, alleluia!
